## Nuisance Laws to Remember

Modesto Municipal Code Section 4-12.703(a) & (b); it is unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to camp, occupy camp facility, or use camp paraphernalia on Public Property or any Private Property unless a temporary permit has been obtained from the City Manager prior to occupying public property or permission has been granted by the private property owner prior.

Modesto Municipal Code Section 4-12.704(a) & (b); It is unlawful and a public nuisance for any person to store personal property, including camp paraphernalia, on any public or private property without the written consent of the property owner..

Modesto Municipal Code Section 5-7.02: Squatter Camp(s) No person shall settle or locate on or occupy any land without a bona fide claim or color of title thereto, or without the express consent of the owner or person legally in charge of said land, or erect or construct any tent, shelter or structure of any kind thereon.

Modesto Municipal Code Section 4-2.34(B)(1),(2),(3),(4),(5),(6); Soliciting prohibited within 25' of a public transportation center, 100' of an intersection, in a public parking lot after sunset, at an Outdoor dining area, 25' of an ATM, and 25' of a group of 5 or more standing in line.

Modesto Municipal Code Section 5-5.203(A) It is unlawful to enter into a waste container without the written consent of the owner.

Modesto Municipal Code Section 4-5.33(C)MMC and California Penal Code Section 647 ( C ) Prohibits Aggressive Panhandling and Begging.

Modesto Municipal Code Section 4-16.203(A) (I) It is unlawful to deprive owner; temporarily or permanently of a shopping cart.

California Penal Code Section 647 (e); Prohibits entering and occupying real property or structures of any kind without the written consent of the owner or agent of that property.

Smoking Prohibited Section 5-8.20(b)(I) Smoking is prohibited in the Modesto Downtown Transportation Center. Where smoking is permitted, a sign in accordance with Section 5-8.601 must be displayed and the designated smoking area must not be within 20 feet of any exit or entrance.

Additionally, all parks are smoke and tobacco free in accordance with section 12-4.202(a)(32) MMC
